Child Sexual Abuse Awareness Raising Training

(Level 1)

About this training:

The harm sexual abuse causes to children can be profound, not just to their emotional and physical development, but to their trust in adults.

Using facilitated discussions this training event will focus thinking on several different areas of child sexual abuse and will provide a base for participants to consider any future training requirements in this area.

Aims:

Following this seminar you will be able to:

- Understand your role and responsibility in protecting children and young people who are being sexually abused;
- Recognise signs, symptoms and behaviours that could give rise to concerns about child sexual abuse;
- Explore the issues around sexual taboos within society, and identify the factors that will influence your actions in response to child sexual abuse;
- Understand the law in relation to consent and sexual offences and young people.

Target Audience:

This is an interactive workshop-led day for all staff or volunteers who work with children, young people and their families and who would like to enhance their knowledge around child sexual abuse.
