### *“Information Sharing and Communication Within and Across Agencies to Protect Children and Young People”*

*This is a repeat of seminars held between 2007 and 2009.*

#### **Target Audience:**

This seminar is aimed at practitioners, team leaders and managers from all agencies involved in the care and protection of children and young people. Also relevant to practitioners, team leaders, managers involved in the provision of services to adults who are parents / carers of children / young people where there may be concerns that the needs of children / young people are not being met, i.e. adult mental health workers, drug and alcohol workers and those who work with adults with learning disabilities.

Participants should have an understanding of their agency's child protection policies and procedures or have previously attended an introductory course on child protection.

- To consider the barriers to sharing information and how to enhance effective communication about children and young people at risk of harm, within and across agencies.
